Research Theme in 2023: Climate Change and Conflict

The Hans Günter Brauch Foundation (HGBS) <<http://hgb-stiftung.org/>> awards an international science prize on scientific themes on peace, ecology and the Anthropocene. The prize is open to scholars working in peace and environmental studies from all social science disciplines and countries. It is awarded annually on a specific research theme by an international jury < http://hgb-stiftung.org/html/Global_Jury.html> consisting of 12 scholars from all continents. **The prize will be awarded on 14 July 2023 in Mosbach (Germany) and** consists of a prize money of **3000 Euro**, an airline ticket and a hotel stay.
